

A Few Guidelines for Visiting Families

Welcome to the Orfaea Family Children's Center! We are happy to have you take the opportunity to visit our program. Please keep in mind the following simple guidelines in order for your visit to be as informative, enjoyable and unobtrusive as possible.

1. Check in at the front desk. You will be given a visitor's tag to wear while in the classrooms. Please return the tag as you leave after the observation.
2. 'Blend in with the surroundings!' After being introduced to the teachers, feel free to observe the class for as long as you like. Please try to be as unobtrusive as possible by sitting at the children's level on a child-sized chair, on the floor or on the grass.
3. If you think of any questions during your visit, the program coordinator or receptionist will be happy to answer them. As the teachers' attention needs to be with the children, **please understand that they are unable to answer questions or carry on extended conversations during your classroom visit.** Shortly before your child's first day, please schedule an appointment with the lead teacher of your child's class to share individual information about your child and details of the class.
